**Broken Oak Ranch "Share The Legacy" Performance Tested Bull Sale  
December 10, 2009 – At The Ranch, Seguin, TX**

On a day after the warmest day on record in San Antonio for December 9<sup>th</sup>, which 7 hours later produced snow and freezing rain in San Antonio, buyers turned out at Broken Oak Ranch on a chilly, windy day to make their herd bull selections.

Bulls were pre-priced and claimed then later open bidding began as producers sorted through a top cut of long-yearling and yearling bulls being offered.

Topping the sale was MR BOR 0823S ET, a 11/9/06 son of Polled Vision and out of the legendary BOR Donor, "Phenomenon",. The bull scanned a 1.51 REA/CWT, .14 BF and IMF of 3.34 and ranks in the top 1% for Marbling and top 15% on REA with a 112 WWR. Bull sold to Colorado at \$4,500.

MR BOR 2644T, another top Polled Vision son sold to Alabama at \$3,100. This 3/16/07 purebred had a REA/CWT of 1.51, BF .23 and IMF of 3.48 with a WWR of 104 and YWR of 106 and was the top gaining bull in the offering in his age group.

MR BOR 0405T, a 4/20/07 son of Black Joker and out of the low-birth herd sire, "F007", was another popular choice at \$2,600 selling to Texas. This bull scanned a 1.33 REA/CWT, .23 BF and 3.6 IMF while posting a WWR of 112 and YWR of 101. Another Texas buyer selected MR BOR 1665T ET, a 10/20/07 son of "Cornerstone" out of a full sister to Polled Thunder. The Homozygous polled yearling posted a REA/CWT of 1/32, BF .14 and IMF of 2.32.
